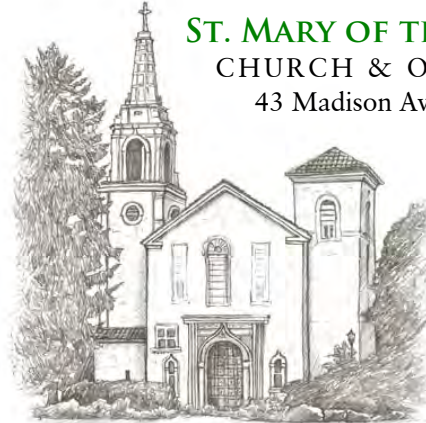

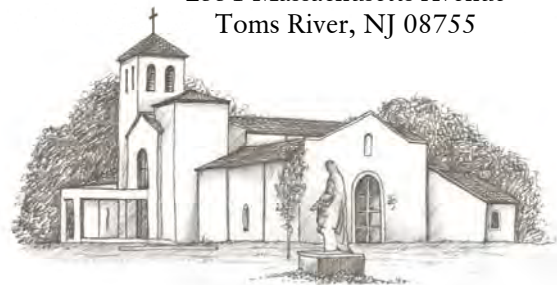

OUR LITURGY

Weekly Reflection

"If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but handed him over for us all, how will he not also give us everything else along with him... Christ Jesus it is who died, or rather was raised, who also is at the right hand of God who indeed intercedes for us."

A persistent danger for us during our Lenten observance and practices is to focus only on the events of Calvary and the paschal mystery which occurred. We may know details of the passion, death and resurrection, and recall and remember. Something else ought to happen.

The passion of Jesus continues today in the suffering of disciples throughout the world. Religious persecution continues, and because it occurs in distant places in the world it is real and affects the entire church, the entire body of Christ.

Thus Paul reminds us that it is the Risen Christ interceding for all of us today. May we join Peter, James and John with Christ on the mountain and hear echo, 'This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him.' May we pray to and for the suffering Christ today.

LENTEN OBSERVANCES

The foundational call of Christians to charity is a frequent theme of the Gospels. During Lent, we are asked to focus more intently on "almsgiving," which means donating money or goods to the poor and performing other acts of charity. As one of the three pillars of Lenten practice, almsgiving is "a witness to fraternal charity" and "a work of justice pleasing to God." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2462).



Just as God has been merciful to us, we must be merciful to others. This includes acting with compassion and charity toward those in need. Feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick, visiting the imprisoned, and burying the dead. There are several special opportunities for almsgiving through donations to Church ministries for which collections are conducted during the Lenten season including

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

Days of Fast and Abstinence. Limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence (All Fridays in Lent):

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Week Days of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Easter Duty Obligation:

The Bishop has extended the dispensation for receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Holy Communion during the Easter Season— but reminds all to try to receive from the First Sunday of Lent, to Trinity Sunday, May 30, 2021.
